It is my privilege to write a letter recommending the Country House Restaurant. This past fall Country House assumed our cafeteria operations at St. Rita of Cascia High School. They serve breakfast and lunch to our 760 students and 100 faculty and staff.

First of all, the food is nourishing, plentiful and delicious. The menus are varied and interesting. The students, faculty and staff speak very positively about the food service here at St. Rita. This alone would make me want to recommend Country House.

But, in addition, Country House takes full responsibility for the operation of our kitchen, cafeteria line and dining hall. They take care of ordering all the food, both perishable and non-perishable. They are very judicious in the amounts of food they keep on hand and maintain a very low inventory.
